\*Review and Approval of Glen Alpine Zoning Ordinance-PP by Bradley Kirkley and Patrick Dickinson(Burke Co)

R. Scott made motion to approve the Zoning Ordinance presented by Burke Co, all in favor, passed

\*Paving of track at the Park & Concrete at Veterans Memorial-R. Scott

R. Scott wants to have additional parking for the Veterans memorial. The town would have to fund the difference that Powell Bill won't pay for \$9612. L. Boone made motion to approve the paving of the walking area at the park and additional parking at the Veterans Memorial, all in favor, passed.

\*Powell Bill- K. Herron, he stated we need to start looking to see where potholes and side streets that need attention so we can use the Powell Bill funds to make these repairs. Park of his discussion is what Reid Scott already went over.

\*Gas Prices- K. Herron, he stated with the current gas prices, we are saving a little money by going to Quality Mart instead of Thrifty Mart. He was told board members had requested in the past that they only use Thrifty Mart. S. Perkins said she thought they could use either/or.

Clerk Carswell asked if she can order additional gas cards for Police Dept.

S. Perkins stated again that she thinks using either place is ok especially if we can save some money.

\*Budget Questions- K. Herron, he gave the board members a sheet regarding salary increase. He is asking for 2.5% or 5% for all full time employees.

\*Building at 201 W Main St-K. Herron, the part-time employee that we hired is also a plumber so he has been working on the bathroom at the brown building and Western Carolina Plumbing Supply donated a water heater, toilets, sinks, faucets. He is also hoping grant money may help with renovations to that building also. He said a farmers market would be good for temporary use.
